





Just Bakery is a 12-week employment training initiative that works with people experiencing barriers to employment. Participants can gain five nationally recognized certifications, including ServSafe, and receive hands-on commercial baking training. You can earn up to 12 credits to Madison College's culinary program, build resumes, learn Life Skills, and receive individualized resource support.

Circles of Support is a reentry program that provides individuals leaving prison with a support system. Weekly meetings to set goals, talk about life, and get support from a committed group of volunteers.





Peer Support Specialists are available as a resource of support, allowing peers to direct their own reentry process from a strength-based platform, giving the peer a sense of autonomy and pride over their own reentry journey.

The benefits of peer support are based on the premise that those peer specialists who possess lived experience are better able to relate to the peers they work with through a sense of mutuality, having encountered some of the similar challenges associated with mental health, substance use, and/or, pre and post incarceration.

Journey Home works to reduce recidivism (return to prison) by creating a stronger safer community for those returning. It focuses on the areas of residency, employment, support and treatment—as well as transportation and education.
